**Liability Insurance:** Suzanne, WOMMA, researched the cost of liability insurance and presented the annual cost of \$200 for the following coverage:

General Aggregate Limit:	\$2,000,000.00
Personal Limit:	\$1,000,000.00
Each Occurrence Limit:	\$1,000,000.00
Fire Damage Limit (Any One Fire)	\$100,000.00
Medical Expense Limit (Any One Person)	\$10,000.00

**New Business:**

**Liability Insurance:** Discussion was held on whether the club members thought the club should obtain liability insurance. Concern was raised about the low coverage on Medical Expense Limit (Any One Person). Suzanne, WOMMA, agreed to contact the agent to determine if coverage amount could be raised, or if additional medical expense would be covered by the Personal Limit. Motion was made to authorize the Treasurer to spend the money to obtain liability insurance for the club. Motion was seconded and passed.

**Secretary Position Vacant:** The club Secretary, Tim Schmidt, KE0ZQX, has moved to Hays, KS and can no longer fulfill the duties of Secretary. The position is currently vacant.
