New Business

Jim Foster – **KSOVO** M.A.A.R.S. VE ARRL Volunteer Examiner Coordinator Test Sessions will be held 10JUN23 in the 2nd floor Auditorium of the Manhattan Public Library. 629 Poyntz Ave, Manhattan, KS 66502, 0900-1100.

Dave Mills – KD0AZG and Jon Klimek – KE0MHK attended a meeting with Riley County Emergency Management personnel (RCEM.) RCEM has proposed to M.A.A.R.S. the installation of M.A.A.R.S. owned repeater sets, one on each of two Riley County owned tower sites maintained by Ka-comm., Inc. in order to increase M.A.A.R.S. amateur radio coverage area for amateur radio use and strengthening RCEM amateur radio coverage area during weather related emergencies and continued WARN participation. Ka-comm., Inc. will provide the rack system or rack space to support repeater components, install feedline and antenna on the tower. Ka-comm., Inc. will also provide a discount on the cost of materials and labor. RCEM has budgeted \$5K for the project in 2023. If the estimated cost exceeds \$5K the second site will be budgeted for 2024. The two Riley County owned sites would offer M.A.A.R.S. a no rent, no fees, generator backup and internet capability.

The current KSOMAN repeater 147.255 on the KSDB radio station tower will remain with no changes as part of this proposal.

#1 Priority for 2023 funds is to place a 2m repeater on the (Drake Tower) site located on or near 911 Hill near Pillsbury Crossing at appx. 416'.

#2 Priority if 2023 funds allow or in 2024, would be the addition of a 70cm/440 repeater at 25 watts on the (Schurle Signs Inc. North County Tower.) This tower is appx. 300' with the M.A.A.R.S. antenna at appx. 250'-275'.

In order to go further with RCEM's proposal to M.A.A.R.S. Dave Mills – KD0AZG and Jon Klimek – KE0MHK will ask that a contract be created outlining the project, access to the tower sites for

programming and maintenance as well as this agreement is maintained as RCEM personnel change.

Motion Passed to continue moving forward with the Riley County Emergency Management, amateur radio repeater project.

2023 Field Day Preparations – ARRL Field Day 2023 –Tune in the World – will be held June 24-25. Field Day is ALWAYS the fourth full weekend, beginning at 1800 UTC Saturday and ending at 2059 UTC Sunday. Ryan Benteman – **AD0TZ** has reserved the Bob Flemming Shelter TCSP (Tuttle Creek State Park), 5800 River Pond Rd A, Manhattan, KS 66502. A Single "On Air" Radio Station, 106' Single Trapped Dipole Antenna, elevated appx. 60' using Phone, CW and Digital (non-CW) modes. Bring your own CW keyer. There will be 1 operating transmitter connected to 1 antenna to prevent potential damage to transmitters in close proximity.

Matt Hale – **KFOISO** will help with coordination with Ryan Benteman – **ADOTZ** with logistics and operations. John Kovac **Suzanne Asbury** – **W0MMA KOVAC** requested a sign in sheet be created inorder for Hams the ability to sign in for behind the microphone, logging etc. times.

A possibility of a Potluck type meal may be coordinated if participating members want to participate.
